## Invitation ... Call for Presentations & Papers

DIBELS leaders, researchers, and implementation team members are invited to submit presentation proposals for the 2010 DIBELS Summit to be held at Tamaya Resort & Spa in Santa Ana Pueblo, New Mexico, February 23-25, 2010. Session presentations will be selected from this call. Deadline for submission of application is **December 7, 2009**.

Session presentations occur Tuesday morning through Thursday morning, with exciting focus group sessions on Tuesday afternoon. We will begin and end the Summit with dynamic keynote speakers.

Applications are read as part of a juried process by the DIBELS Summit Review Committee. Applicants will be notified of their proposal's status after the committee's evaluation of all entries. Decisions will be mailed to all applicants by **December 18, 2009**.



## Presentation Evaluation Criteria

**Proposal evaluation criteria:** The DIBELS Summit is looking for presentations that are data-based, engaging, thought-provoking, and draw on expertise in DIBELS research, advanced implementation, Response to Intervention, and/or leadership. Proposals must be in writing and conform to the application instructions.

**All proposals must include the Call for Presenters Application Form.**

### Proposals must contain the following:

- **Presentation Title:** Maximum of 10 words to be used in promotion of the presentation.
- **Presentation Description:** Maximum of 75 words detailing session's description. Describe the content of the proposed presentation and intended goals and objectives of the presentation.
- **Presenter Background:** 50 words or less for primary presenter.
- **Primary Contact:** Include mailing address, phone number, fax, and email address.
- **Presentation Type:** Presentation (1.5 hours) or poster session.
- **Strands:**
  - **Research:** These sessions will provide participants with qualitative and quantitative research in the areas of DIBELS, IDEL, interventions, RtI, and other DIBELS topics. Researchers will be asked to present research design, outcomes, and implications. Preference will be given to university and federally funded projects/research.
  - **Advanced Implementation:** These sessions will detail systems-level literacy and/or RtI models that have shown to increase student outcomes based on DIBELS data for the past 3 years. Preference will be given to statewide and/or regional models.
  - **Leadership:** These sessions will detail system-wide approaches to increase student outcomes regarding literacy and DIBELS from a leadership perspective.
  - **Linking DIBELS to Instruction:** These sessions will provide participants with evidence-based practices/strategies to increase student reading outcomes based on DIBELS data. Presenters will be asked to provide outcomes data in addition to describing the practices/strategies that led to positive outcomes. We have the data, now how do we use it to guide instruction?
  - **Pre-Service: Model of Excellence:** These sessions will detail and highlight pre-service programs within universities and colleges that provide a strong foundation for DIBELS, Literacy, RtI, and using data to guide instruction.

## Submission Guidelines

**General:** All submissions received will be reviewed by the DIBELS Summit Review Committee. Selection of presenters will be made by **December 18, 2009**. Notification of acceptance will be mailed immediately following selections. Due to limited program slots, the Review Committee may determine it necessary to assign your session a format different from the one you select. If you are able to accept another format, please indicate on your form (Please note that the alternate format may be a poster session).
